

OT05: What type of cartridge(s) are you using to host LSDj?

F!: I use the LinkNLoad32 USB flash card (4MB ROM, 128KB FRAM). In my opinion, these are the best on the market for LSDJ. I've owned an EZ F!ash Junior, but I've lost countless saves with it, I really don't recommend them.

OT05: Do you have any involvement or plans to get involved in the Game Boy homebrew scene?

F!: Not at the moment, but I've been thinking about creating a Game Boy game related to my musical project, so maybe it'll happen one day!

OT05: Do you plan to work exclusively with the Game Boy? If not, what other consoles or systems are interesting to you?

F!: Not necessarily a console, but like all LSDJ users, my interest in M8 is growing and I think I'll try to get my hands on one when I can. Apart from that, I'm interested in using the Mega Drive / Genesis sound chip and may try to do something in furnace tracker with it one day, but it's not my priority.

OT05: I've found the Bon Voyage EP on YouTube and BandCamp. Do you have any other mediums, projects, or productions that you would like to promote?

F!: At the moment, I'm working on another Game Boy / Chiptune / LSDJ EP that I hope to release in mid-2024, and a second EP that isn't directly related to chiptune but that I hope to release with the alias FLIPPENDO! as well.
