

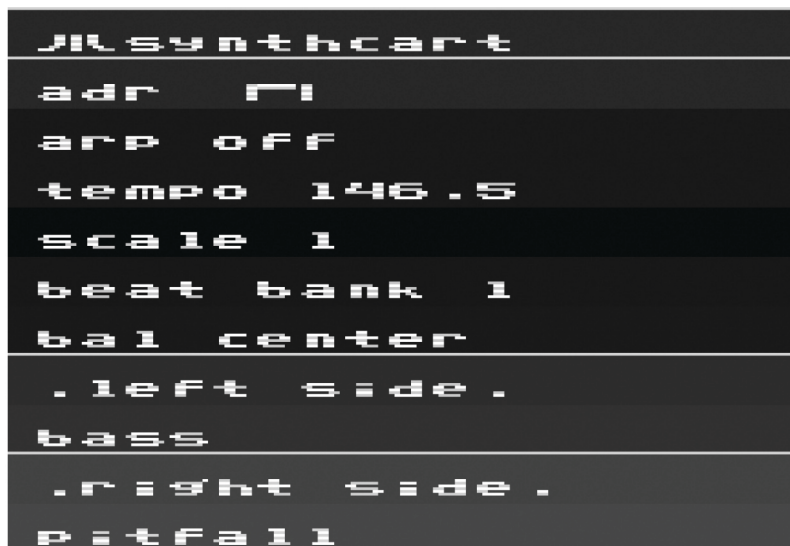

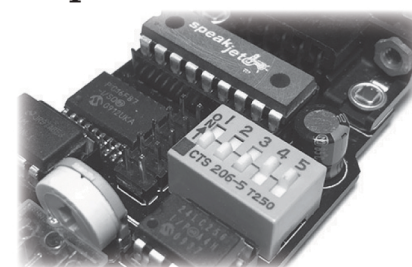
With **Synthcart** you're able to use an Atari 2600 as a drum machine and synthesizer.
