



OT05: For the night GB photography featured in this month's issue you credited a custom Rom. What about the hardware, does 2 Bit PXL Studio work on a stock Game Boy Camera and/or are you using a modded cart or some sort of emulation?

LUCE: So I personally use multiple devices running a modified gameboy color emulator that allows me to use the devices camera as the camera within the emulator, the shots in this months issue for example were all shot with a Pixel 3a running said emulator and the custom rom, usually taken at around 2-3 AM haha.
The Rom itself is no longer in active development but it was built for a custom Gameboy CameraFlashcart that you can flash your own rom too and use the original Gameboy Camera sensor.

OT05: I appreciate you bringing Little GP Tracker to my attention. The more I look into it the more excited I get to try it out. What's your preferred method of running little piggy?

LUCE: I've used Piggy Tracker for roughly a decade now myself and I've used lots of different devices to run it, but a couple of personal favorites tend to be the PocketCHIP from Next Thing Co. and a Sony PSP 1000.

OT05: Little Piggy Tracker appears to lend itself more to Jungle or Breakbeat than some of the other handheld music programs. Is that what attracted you to the program?

LUCE: Piggy being sample/midi based while having the workflow of LSDJ definitely drew me to the program. I've always been interested in trackers, coming from a drummer background and my first ever step into the electronic music scene was actually with LSDJ. A few years later I discovered Piggy Tracker and loved the fact that it was sample based, and making breakbeat and jungle on it was definitely my go-to.

OT05: You run the current LGPT discord, The Pig Pen, do you find running a discord more stressful, satisfying, or in the somewhere in the middle?

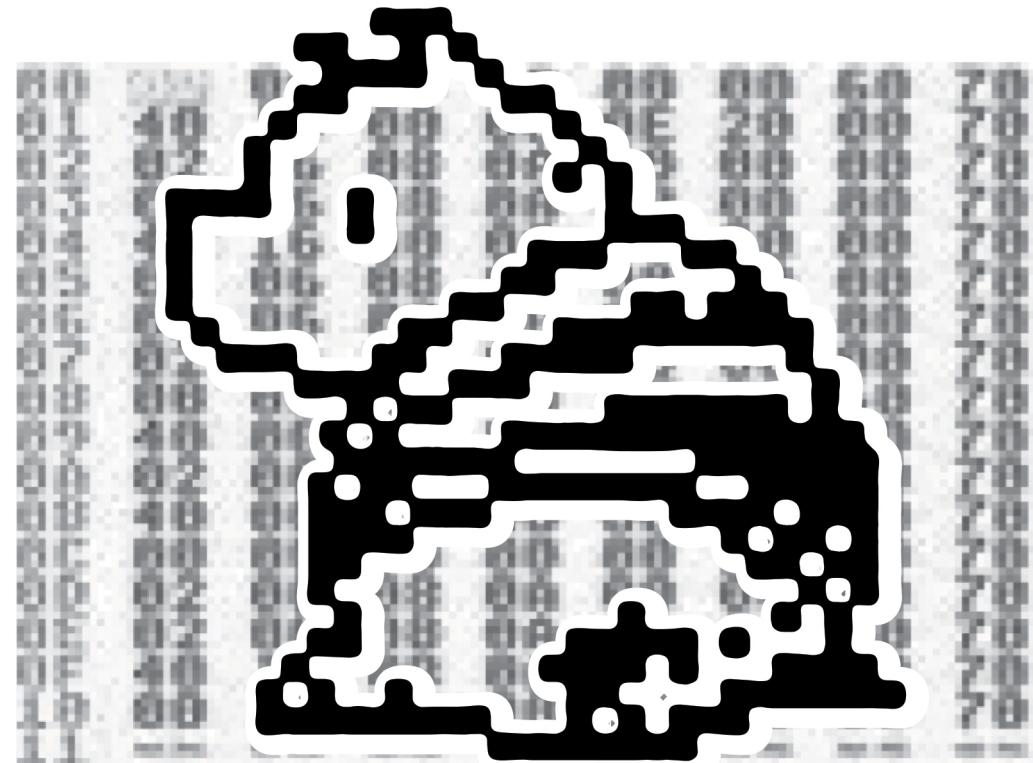
